Planning

Application 31/2017/0525

Proposal Removal of 3 hedgerows to facilitate the installation of a 132kv electricity cable

Location Land south of Glascoed Road, St Asaph

The council had no objections.

Co-opted member

Two applications were received by interested parties – Mr Michael Lovegrove and Mr Trevor Hughes. There was a secret ballot and Mr Hughes was the successful candidate.

Roads and lighting

The fence at the back of Mairwen has been done but the bases of the concrete posts remain there protruding. The surface of the road from Pentre Mawr to Groesffordd Marli needs resurfacing. The side of the road by Lodge Bach is rough on the Glascoed Road. The gullies are blocked by Ffordd y Glascoed houses No. 1-8 and also by Memoria Crematorium. Two large and deep pot holes on the side of the road between Cae Onnen and Willow Cottage. On side Acar the road is rough and uneven.

Letters

A letter had been written by Mr Barlow regarding the parking at Memoria. All Councillors agreed with the letter and the Clerk was to send it.

The fighting of the pylons have lost their appeal against pylons above ground and wanted a donation towards costs. The Councillors agreed to give £100 this was proposed by Karin Jones and seconded by Mr D Williams.

There will be an emergency finance meeting once the accounts are returned.
